

Bioheat[®] fuel takes the **benefits of ULSHO and turns them green!** Bioheat[®] fuel blends renewable biodiesel with ULSHO to substantially reduce carbon emissions. Valley Oil currently provides every customer with a blend of at least 2 percent biodiesel and ULSHO. Bioheat reduces carbon emissions to improve air quality, dissolves sediments in your storage tank, and makes your heating equipment run more efficiently. Our goal is to deliver B50 by 2030 and a fully renewable, net-zero carbon fuel to you before 2050. It is dangerous and time-consuming for our delivery technicians to climb over snow banks or risk their safety on icy surfaces. If you don't clear a path, you are delaying service to your neighbors. Our drivers have the right to protect themselves and postpone your fuel delivery in unsafe conditions. If you are unable to clear a path for any reason, please let us know, so we can adjust your deliveries accordingly.

The New Jersey Energy Master Plan (EMP) is a plan to reach 100 percent clean energy by 2050. As a 50-year family-owned business, we agree with that goal to protect our children, grandchildren and future. We have serious concerns, however, with the EMP's plan to get there.
